THE PURPOSE

People with psychiatric disabilities have difficulties in getting a job. Without a job equates to no income. It leads on to feelings of hopelessness and worthlessness. Major hurdles to securing a job include:

- Employers' unwillingness to employ people with psychiatric disabilities
- Lack of working experience of our members due to their illnesses
- Side effects of medication may reduce their ability to hold on to a job
- Frequent medical appointments could reduce their chances of gaining employment

WHAT IS MOSES ALL ABOUT?

Moses Gift Shop

This is a gift shop manned by our members. It displays items produced by our very own members and other gift items to make your shopping experience more enjoyable. The shop also doubles up as a showroom for contract jobs performed by our members for commercial partners.

Moses Pushcarts

This is a project supported by commercial entities and institutions who provide us with a retail space. This is a fantastic opportunity for our members. They attempt to learn a new skill in retail sales, which will assist and strengthen their communication skills with the public.

External Sales Events

We are often given the opportunity to market our products at special events and carnivals organized by churches or community organizations. This is another avenue to market our products and to acquire sales experience.

We are developing our Centre to become a place for the public to shop. Shops sell household items, fashion items, gifts and food items at very affordable price. From time to time, we also organize in-house flea market events to give our members another opportunity to practice salesmanship.
